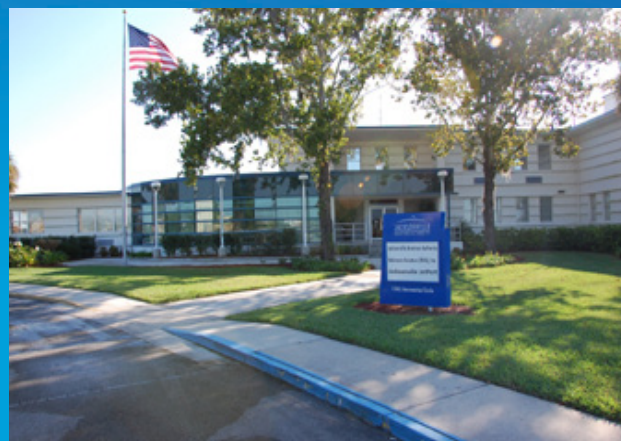

## Cecil Field Operational Base Support Capabilities

### Fueling capabilities

- Rapid Fueling service with Navy qualified ground crews
- Designated hot pump site and certified hot pump procedures
- Contract Fuel (DESC) - Jet A and JP 8 fuel available



### Quality of Life - - Transportation, Lodging and other personnel services

- Rental Cars (Enterprise and Hertz)
- Hotels - **military per diem rates available**
- Nearby Restaurants and catered meals as requested
- Free water bottles provided each day
- Gym on site
- Golf courses nearby – one on base
- Jacksonville downtown only 20 minutes away
- NAS Jacksonville Navy base 10 miles to east
- Area beaches and other attractions

### Airfield assets

- 12,500 Ft. Runway plus 3 - 8,000 Ft. Runways
- Tower controlled, ILS & GPS Approaches, suitable for NVG training
- Low volume traffic in pattern and on taxiways
- Large buffer area surrounding field for safety and noise concerns
- Large open ramp areas
- Fire protection - 24 Hour ARFF
- 24 hour secure airside (Gated with badge controlled access to runway/ramp areas)
- Generally excellent year round flying weather



### Maintenance

- Hangar available for O level maintenance
- Yellow gear available including electric and air carts
- Hi Power areas



## Cecil Field Available Training Facilities

### Training/ Ops Building - available year round

- 4000 sq. ft. Training/Classroom Building
- Large and fully outfitted maintenance control office with maintenance control counter and desks, easy access to ramp and aircraft
- Ops Duty Office- Complete with VIDS boards
- Two briefing rooms for pilots, wall mounted TV
- Ready room - large enough to sit 20 or more pilots, easy access to ramp and aircraft
- Wireless throughout the entire building
- Central Heat & Air throughout the entire building
- Two offices for CO/XO and QA
- Adequate FREE parking for pilots and ground crew
- Kitchen area complete with coffee, microwave, toasters and refrigerators



### Ramp-side

- Para Loft - Padded hooks for flight gear for 50 pilots, large inspection table
- Line shack - with windows facing ramp, outfitted with refrigerator, desks and couch
- Hazmat locker and oily rag disposal area
- 230,000 sq. ft. concrete ramp with tie downs
- In depth FOD program for ramps and runways



- New Fleet hangar under construction. 3000 sq. ft. can be made available for training squadrons as needed (construction to be complete summer 2011)
  - 1000 sq. ft. of separate shop space available in new hangar
